

Memorial Day Observances to be held Monday

Memorial Day will be observed this year on Monday, May 28. Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 3232 invites the public to join them at three events being held that day to recognize the sacrifice made by veterans that have perished while defending America. At 7 a.m., members of Post 3232 and the VFW Honor Guard will gather at the Pacific Sunset Cemetery to honor Memorial Day. The recognition will consist of a ceremonial raising of the flag to the top of the flagpole and then lowered to half-staff as Taps is played. At noon the flag will be raised to full staff.

At 8 a.m. the group will be placing white crosses and American flags at all veterans' grave sites. The public is invited to help with this annual honoring. At 1 p.m., Memorial Day services will be held at the Veteran's Memorial Park in Old Town. United States Coast Guard Station Siuslaw River will be participating in the ceremonies honoring those that have perished defending freedom by placing memorial wreaths on the Siuslaw River at this time. Floral wreaths may be placed at the park prior to the service for proper laying of the wreath by the Coast Guard.

Book Review
 "Disappearance at Devil's Rock"
 By Paul Tremblay
 "Disappearance at Devil's Rock" is the latest from best-selling author Paul Tremblay, whose previous novel "A Head Full of Ghosts" received critical acclaim. Late one summer night, Elizabeth Sanderson receives the devastating news that every mother fears: her 13-year-old son, Tommy, has vanished without a trace in the woods of a nearby state park. The search isn't yielding any answers, and Elizabeth and her 11-year-old daughter, Kate, struggle to comprehend Tommy's disappearance. Feeling helpless and alone, their sorrow is compounded by anger and frustration. Neither the state nor local police have uncovered any leads. Josh and Luis, the friends who were the last to see Tommy before he vanished, may not be telling the whole truth about that night in Borderland State Park, when they were supposedly hanging out at a landmark they have remained Devil's Rock. Living in an all-too-real nightmare, Elizabeth is wholly unprepared for the strange series of events that follow. She believes a wraithlike apparition of Tommy materializes in her bedroom, while Kate and other local residents claim to see a shadowy figure peering through their windows in the dead

of night. Then, random pages torn from Tommy's journals begin to mysteriously appear — entries that reveal an introverted teenage obsessed with the phantasmagoric; the loss of his father, killed in a drunk-driving accident a decade earlier; a folktale involving the devil and the woods of Borderland; the coming zombie "pocketclips"; and a horrific incident that Tommy believed connected them all. As the search grows more desperate, and the implications of what happened become more ominous and sinister, no one is prepared for the shocking truth about that night at Devil's Rock. Paul Tremblay blends literary fiction, psychological suspense, and supernatural horror into an absorbing tale that illuminates a parent's darkest fears ... and an adolescent's darkest secrets. Eerie, thought-provoking, and soul-shattering, "Disappearance at Devil's Rock" will haunt you long after Tommy's final journey entry is read. **Friends of the Library Book Sale** The Friends of the Siuslaw Public Library will be holding their next book sale on Saturday, June 2, and Sunday, June 3, in the library's Bromley Room.
