COMMINGLED RECYCLING

Images pictured below are not all-inclusive. All commingled materials must be clean.

DEPOSIT MATERIALS LOOSE. **NO PLASTIC BAGS.** DO NOT FLATTEN CONTAINERS.

Other shaped plastics

Most sites have a separate bin for cardboard.

Materials Below Continue To Be Collected In Separate Bins At Designated Sites.

Glass Jars & Bottles

ALL SITES

YES

- Rinse
- Lids & labels okay
- All colors in one bin



NO

- Window glass
- Drinking glass
- Light bulbs
- Pyrex



Corrugated Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags

ALL SITES

YES

- Look for wavy inner layer
- Remove contents of flattened boxes



NO

- Other paper boards & packing material
- Waxed cardboard
- Dirty pizza boxes



Plastic Bags & Sheeting

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

Temporary Closed

- Completely remove contents
- Turn inside out & shake to clean



NO

- Trash bags, black bags
- Bubble wrap, air bubble packs (unless ALL air is removed)



Scrap Metal

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES

- All items that are 75% metal or more
- Remove all liquids
- All drums/barrels must have large visible holes



Empty oil & gas

NO

- Liquids
- Refrigerators, freezers, water coolers, heat pumps, air conditioners or dehumidifiers
- Pressurized containers



Electronic Waste

ACCEPTED @ CRESWELL, COTTAGE GROVE, FLORENCE, GLENWOOD, MARCOLA, OAKRIDGE, RATTLESNAKE, VENETA & VIDA

YES

- TVs, computer CPUs & monitors
- Keyboards, printers, mice
- Phones, stereos, VCRs, DVDs

MAXIMUM 7 ITEMS PER VISIT



NO

- Commercial or floor-standing copiers
- Parts, dismantled or salvaged units
- Speakers, reel-to-reel, or packaging



Wood Waste

Fee item, see your fee collector

ACCEPTED @ COTTAGE GROVE, FLORENCE, & GLENWOOD

YES

- Broken furniture
- Painted wood
- Particle board
- Pallets
- Wood with nails or screws



NO

- Formica, foam core or plastic coated
- Hardware bigger than your thumb
- Laminated wood
- Mixed materials
- Railroad ties



Yard Debris

Fee item, see your fee collector

ACCEPTED @ COTTAGE GROVE, FLORENCE, & GLENWOOD

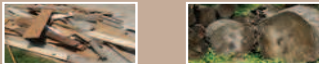
YES

- Cut grass, brush and leaves
- Limbs under 12" diameter



NO

- Lumber, stumps or root wads
- Limbs over 12" diameter



Propane Tanks & Disposable helium tanks

Fee item, see your fee collector

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES



NO

- Other compression tanks, containers or product types

Antifreeze

Place in drum

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES

- Store in unbreakable containers with secure lid
- For residential use only – maximum 15 gallons



NO

- Contaminants (oil, fuel, etc.)
- Empty antifreeze containers are NOT recyclable

Motor Oil—Pour in collection container Oil Filters—Place in drum

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES

- Store in unbreakable containers with secure lid
- For residential use only – maximum 15 gallons



NO

- Water, brake fluid, contaminants
- Gasoline, diesel, solvents
- Business or farm collection
- Empty motor oil containers are NOT recyclable

Household Batteries

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES

- All button, & rechargeable batteries
- All Nicad, Lithium, Silver Oxide & Mercury batteries
- Alkaline batteries older than 1996



NO

- Alkaline batteries made after 1996 sizes AAA-D (okay to toss in garbage)
- Commercial or industrial batteries



Auto Batteries

All types & sizes of auto & other lead-acid batteries

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES



Sharps (Needles)

Lancets & other medical sharps

ALL SITES EXCEPT SHARPS CREEK

YES

- Pack in rigid red sealed container (red laundry detergent container okay)
- Make sure lid is secure
- Household sources only



NO

- Other containers such as glass, milk jugs, coffee cans or non-rigid containers
- Material from commercial generators, clinics, etc.
