Western Lane Community Foundation will award its annual \$3,000 Arlis Ulman Health Careers Scholarship to a Lane Community College (LCC) Florence Center student this summer.

This scholarship was established in 2012 by WLCF to assist local students attending LCC in the field of health care and was named in honor of Arlis Ulman, a longtime volunteer with the foundation who served on its board of directors for nine years.
