It's a great time for trout fishing

Air and water temperatures are starting to heat up — and both fish and anglers are getting more active. Dozens of waterbodies are being stocked this week, and many others will still have fish from earlier stockings. Check out the zone reports for the latest conditions.

Warmwater fishing heating up

Smallmouth bass on the John Day or Umpqua rivers, walleye on the upper Columbia, bluegill on Empire Lakes, largemouth bass on Tenmile Lakes, crappie on Willow Creek Reservoir — take your pick! There are great warmwater fisheries in every corner of the state. You'll find fishing updates in the zone reports.

Spring Chinook ain't over yet

Anglers are still finding fair to good fishing for spring Chinook from the Oregon Coast to the northeast corner of the state. Check out reports for the Siletz, Rogue, Clackamas, North Fork and Santiam rivers.
