## FEC to host 'Spirit of Summer' reception July 11

The public is invited to join artists and patrons of the artists at a reception celebrating the "Spirit of Summer" exhibit at the Florence Events Center (FEC) during the months of July and August.

The exhibit is in Galleries One and Five, and can be viewed daily during FEC business hours, Monday through Friday.

## 'Tis the (brush fire) season

Just after 3 p.m. on Sunday, Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue firefighters responded to reports of a small brush fire off 12th Street, in the wooded area behind the Florence Business Center. Fire crews responding in wildland firefighting gear quickly extinguished the fire, which had grown to about a 20-by-20 foot area in a heavily wooded section of the hillside. The exact cause of the fire has yet to be determined, but remnants of several encampments were in the area and spread throughout the hillside. It was the second brushfire call of the day, with the first being a small fire earlier that morning in a wooded area across the street from the Florence Events Center on Quince Street. With dry weather and high temperatures last week, coupled with predictions for even drier, hotter weather this week, fire danger is extremely high. The community is asked to use extreme caution when working outdoors with combustible equipment and to keep vigilant regarding potential fire dangers, especially over the Fourth of July holiday.

## Yachats holds successful tsunami evacuation exercise

The City of Yachats successfully completed its community tsunami evacuation exercise on June 23 between 10 and 11 a.m.

Safety monitors observed 153 community members evacuate to high ground, with many of them bringing their pets and prepared "go bags."

The drill is part of Yachats' continuing commitment to provide residents and visitors

with relevant information and options for a variety of natural disasters — not just tsunamis, but earthquakes, wildfire and infrastructure failures.

The Lincoln County Sheriff's Office emergency notification system (Lincoln Alerts) provided an electronic notice 15 minutes prior to the exercise to community members who are signed up with the system.

There was no siren, and traffic was not stopped, but ODOT reader boards and LCSO warning signs were placed on both ends of the small town.

Several public safety organizations assisted with the exercise: Lincoln County Sheriff's Office Patrol and Emergency Management, South Lincoln Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), City of

Yachats Emergency Preparedness Committee volunteers, Yachats Rural Fire Protection District, Oregon Department of Transportation and City of Yachats staff.

The city received its NOAA "National Weather Service Tsunami-Ready City" status in 2012 and is required to conduct periodic exercises and community outreach.

## Military museum to celebrate anniversary Saturday

The Oregon Coast Military Museum will host its third anniversary celebration on Saturday, July 7, with a reduced admission price of \$1.

Hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Food will be provided by both Hukilau and Pop's Smokehouse food trucks. In addition, Ex-Officio Board member Dave Burkett and Civil War Historian will be roaming in uniform to answer questions and share Civil War stories.

Music from the Old Time Fiddlers Association will be heard throughout the day. Two different raffles will be going on the day of the event with nearly \$900 in raffle prizes

in one, as well as \$5 raffle tickets for a \$200 value scenic air tour compliments of Aero Legends Biplane ride.

In addition to tickets the day of the event, biplane raffle tickets are available now at the museum, Banner Bank, Beach House Gifts on Bay Street and Florence Tech Solutions.

This event is held at the same time as the annual Wings & Wheels Fly-in and Car Show at the adjacent Florence Municipal Airport, where the museum's USAF Jeep will be leading military vehicle convoys.
