'Tis the (brush fire) season



Just after 3 p.m. on Sunday, Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue firefighters responded to reports of a small brush fire off 12th Street, in the wooded area behind the Florence Business Center. Fire crews responding in wildland firefighting gear quickly extinguished the fire, which had grown to about a 20-by-20 foot area in a heavily wooded section of the hillside. The exact cause of the fire has yet to be determined, but remnants of several encampments were in the area and spread throughout the hillside. It was the second brushfire call of the day, with the first being a small fire earlier that morning in a wooded area across the street from the Florence Events Center on Quince Street. With dry weather and high temperatures last week, coupled with predictions for even drier, hotter weather this week, fire danger is extremely high. The community is asked to use extreme caution when working outdoors with combustable equipment and to keep vigilant regarding potential fire dangers, especially over the Fourth of July holiday.
