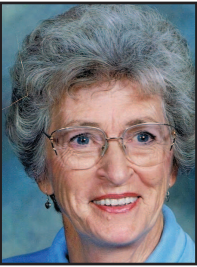

She had a passion for paint-

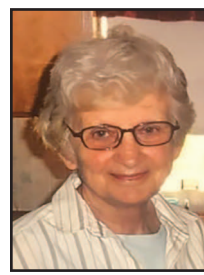
ing, sewing, gardening, hiking and enjoyed garage sales and other activities with her SorgenFri and Church friends.

Heceta Water District board positions open

There are three Board of Director seats on the Heceta Water District that will be up for election in the November election. Heceta Water PUD is divided into five subdivisions. To be qualified to run for these seats, applicants must currently live within the subdivision with an open seat, be a registered voter and have lived in Heceta

Water PUD for two years prior to the election.

The term is for four years, and the board generally meets once a month throughout the year.
