Lane County Justice Court, located in Florence, is responsible for the adjudication of violations and misdemeanors filed as violations of traffic, truck-overload, truancy, civil complaints, Lane County Code violations (such as animal regulation, parks, Lane ESD and waste management complaints) and related post-adjudicative processes. Lane County Sheriff's **Office** correctional services include a jail that houses 256 local offenders, a 39-bed Community Corrections Center (work release) and out-of-custody programs such as Community Service and Sheriff's Work Crew.

Note that a fee is charged at many noncity parks, picnic and day-use areas; a parking fee, for example, is required year-round at all Lane County parks.
