Fortunately, there is another form of golf.

Disc golf is becoming more and more popular. The disc (essentially a Frisbee) is thrown towards a target basket. The scoring is the same as golf; the low score wins.

The target is a pole with tent like chains linked to a basket approximately four feet high.

A disc course is also similar to golf. There are short par-3 holes and longer holes to challenge the disc play-

In 1970, as I stepped onto the Pacific University campus, a Frisbee landed near me. A group of students was tossing a Frisbee. I picked it up and tossed it back poorly, as I recall. I have no memory of ever throwing a Frisbee before that day.

Most people are unaware, as I was before writing this column, that there is a NDGA (National Disc Golf Association) in America. It is a fast-growing sport with championships national held annually, with professional disc golfers compete for prize money.

When I taught a lifetime sports class at Siuslaw High School, my disc golf "goals" were hula hoops scattered in the fields behind the high school. The longest hole began at the south goal post and ended in the outfield of the JV softball field; it was my par-5.

Players had to land inside the hula hoop to "sink the shot" and we used only one sized Frisbee. By comparison, the pros carry as many as 15 discs in their bag, with each disc used for a different situation, similar to the kinds of club one carries in a golf bag.

I favor disc golf for three main reasons. First, you can play for free in many public parks. For example, there is one in Coos Bay.

Another reason is that I have never lost a disc playing disc golf. And the third reason is that throwing mo-



tions are generally the same, and you do not have to hit out of a sand trap.

As more players play, more courses are being included in parks. Some golf courses are even installing disc courses on their golf courses.

Another Frisbee game is Ultimate Frisbee. In this game, one team of players

attempt to move the Frisbee the length of the field and score points when caught in the goal area. Frisbees are also used in freestyle competitions and dog catch competitions.

Whichever you play, the goal is to provide alternative and inexpensive sports that can be played by individuals of all ages.


