

Account opened for family of Swisshome man killed in motorcycle accident

MAPLETON—Late last Saturday, Aug. 4, Oregon State Police (OSP) reported to the scene of a fatal motor vehicle collision that occurred along Highway 36, near milepost 3, just east of Mapleton.

At around 9:30 p.m., troopers arrived to find that a 2007 Honda CBR motorcycle, ridden by 36-year-old Trevor Bernhardt of Swisshome, had struck the back

end of a large 1998 Black Dodge Ram 1500 pickup, operated by Joshua Lee, age 24, of Mapleton.

The OSP investigation determined that Bernhardt had been traveling eastbound when he rounded a corner and rear-ended the truck as it was turning northward onto

North Fork Siuslaw Road. Bernhardt sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased at the scene by medical personnel.

Lee sustained no injuries in the accident.

Bernhardt leaves behind his wife of 16 years, Adrienne Brooks, and their five children:

Alissa, Ryan, Jeffrey, Arista and Hunter.

An account has been set up at Banner Bank in Adrianne Brooks' name, from which donations will go directly to Brooks and her children.

Oregon State Police was assisted on scene by Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue, Deadwood Creek Fire Service, Western Lane Ambulance Service and Oregon Department of Transportation.

Prepare for disaster, emergencies at Be Ready Expo

The Siuslaw News and Western Lane Emergency Operations Group are holding an event in order to connect residents on the Oregon coast with businesses and emergency service providers to raise awareness about disaster preparedness. The Be Ready — Storm Ready Disaster Expo will be on Saturday, Aug. 25, from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Florence Events Center, 715 Quince St.

The event will include speakers and demos that will help prepare community members

for the increasing vulnerability to extreme weather and water events. We live in the most severe weather-prone country on Earth. Where Florence is located on the Oregon Coast, in the event of a natural disaster, it will likely be cut off from major cities and resources a minimum of 10 days — probably more.

"This event is a great opportunity for residents on the Oregon coast to learn how to prepare for and recover from disasters such as tsunamis, earthquakes and floods," stated Jenna Bartlett, General Manager of the Siuslaw News and event organizer.

This free event will feature interactive vendor booths, demonstrations and seminars

to help people better assist their families and the community in the event of a natural disaster.

The keynote speaker, author Dave Robinson, is a disaster preparedness newspaper columnist who will show the average person who to prepare for a disaster with minimal expense and a little ingenuity.

In addition, the event also offers an Emergency Suturing Class taught by PeaceHealth emergency physicians. People should register before the event. Also, the Kiwanis Club of Florence Oregon will be offering a free hot dog lunch from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

As a bonus, the first 300 attendees will receive a 2.5-gallon water storage container.
