This year's event will feature new guild member Amy Anderson, along with seven other members including Linda Nordin and Carol Summers.

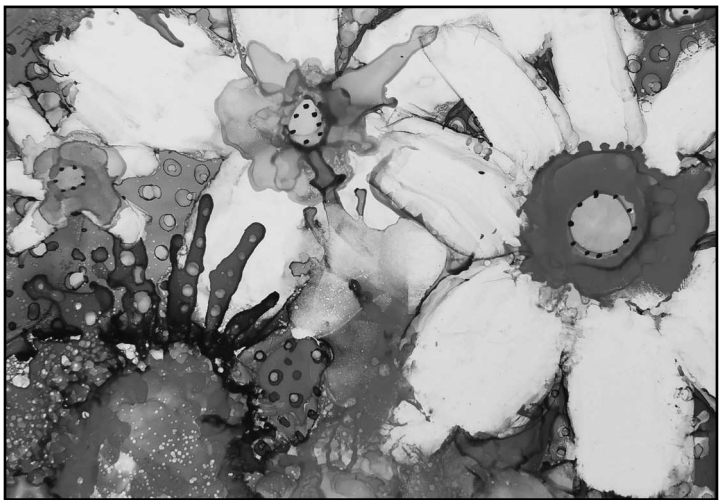
Anderson has been teaching acrylic ink on tile work-

DUNGENESS CRAB



BBQ SALMON

INGREDIENTS:
1 1/2 pounds Salmon Fillet
Lemon Pepper to taste
Garlic Powder to taste
Salt to taste
1/3 cup soy sauce
1/3 cup brown sugar
1/3 cup water
1/4 cup vegetable oil

Preparation:
Season salmon fillets with lemon pepper, garlic powder, and salt.
In small bowl, stir together soy sauce, brown sugar, water and vegetable oil until sugar is dissolved.
Place salmon in a large resealable plastic bag with soy sauce mixture. Seal the bag and turn to make sure fish is coated.
Refrigerate for at least 2 hours.

Cook:
Preheat grill to medium heat.
Lightly oil grill grate. Place salmon on the preheated grill, discard marinade. Cook salmon for 6-8 minutes per side or until fish flakes easily with a fork.

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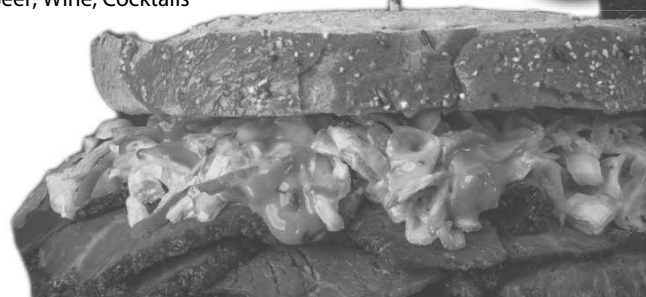


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
