Florence-Yachats Connector Service begins Sept. 4

The long-awaited inter-city transit pilot project between Florence and Yachats is set to begin Tuesday, Sept. 4, at 8 a.m. Tickets are \$2.50 one-way and \$5 for all-day service.

The bus will make four round-trips each day, departing from the Florence Grocery Outlet stop, 2066 Highway 101, making one stop at Carl G. Washburne State Park, then arriving in Yachats at the Log Church, Third and Pontiac streets.

Service hours are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 7:35 p.m., except holidays.

Saturday service is expected to begin later this year.

Tickets are available for cash purchase on the bus — though the driver cannot make change — or through River Cities Taxi, 1699 Pine St., Florence.

This vehicle is fully accessible and bicycles are welcome, space permitting.
