

OCMM HOSTING FIRST GOLF TOURNEY SEPT. 22

The Oregon Coast Military Museum (OCMM) is holding its first-ever golf tournament Saturday, Sept. 22, at the Florence Golf Links on 35th Street in Florence.

The new event will feature a fun and different format on each hole, along with raffle prizes, a hole-in-one for a boat, closest-to-the-pin; and longest drive for both women and men.

The \$100 registration fee includes the award dinner following the tournament, served at the museum on Kingwood Street, with food by Pop's Smokehouse. This is an important fund-

raiser to maintain the museum's mission "to honor our veterans by educating our Public."

Jon Hornung, "It was scary." First responders from Western Lane Ambulance arrived and put Vazquez onto a special split backboard that allowed them to keep the Siuslaw junior completely immobilized and on her side during transport to Peace Harbor Hospital.

"I couldn't even remember where we were in our rotation or even who had served last," said Hornung. "That all seemed pretty unimportant at that moment."

As Vazquez was taken away, Siuslaw players wiped away tears and stood in a huddle, arms draped over each other.

Siuslaw senior Falon Borgino offered a hug to Vazquez's mother before joining the huddle as the game resumed.

"We just talked about how every point for the rest of the game was for Aylenne," said Richards.

Despite that declaration, it took a while for the Lady Vikings to find their momentum. But once they did, they scored a lot for Vazquez.

Junior Mia Collins delivered the first point since early in the set, scoring a kill that drew loud cheers from a packed student section.

Senior Makenzie York followed with two more kills as Siuslaw tied the game at 9-9.

The Lady Viks never trailed again, with York scoring 8 more kills in the set and sophomore Lindsey Long serving three aces. Coupled with kills from sophomore Delanie Foglio and great defense from freshman libero Hayden Muller, Siuslaw went on to win the set — and the match — 25-17.

Afterward, students and family gathered around players for the alma mater as the excitement of the win

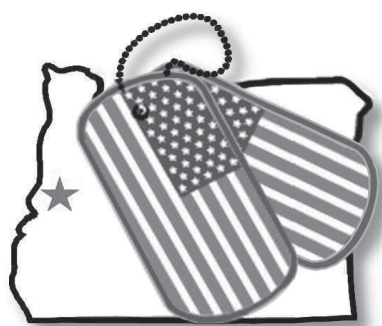
