State Rep. Caddy McKeown was in Florence on Monday at the Siuslaw Public Library, for a question and answer forum for local constituents. McKeown represents Oregon House District 9, which stretches from the Southern end of Coos Bay to the Northern end of Yachats.

She was first elected in 2012 and currently sits on the House Agriculture & Natural Resources committee, the House Committee on Trade and Economic Development and the Joint Committee on Transportation Preservation and Modernization. She is also a member of the Legislative Commission on Indian Services, the Pacific States Marine Fisheries Commis-

sion, as well as serving on the Oregon Coastal Caucus.

The incumbent gave a brief presentation and then answered questions from the 30 or so audience members
