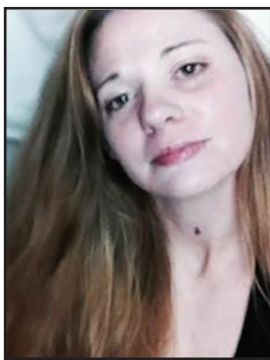
- David Michael Trevino
