

## Project improves boater, angler access in Reedsport

**REEDSPORT** — Boaters and anglers now have improved access to the lower Umpqua River in Reedsport, now that the Rainbow Plaza boat ramp is complete. Rainbow Plaza is a popular and heavily used boat launch facility with an estimated 10,000 boat launches per

As part of this project, a new

piece of land was purchased and an old building removed, along with expanding the parking lot at the site. Old derelict pilings were removed and the boat launch was widened to improve navigability and congestion.

Additionally, a new ADA flush restroom was installed, debris deflectors and boarding docks were installed, and parking lot was reconfigured with new curbs, islands, sidewalks and a storm water treatment system. A new fish cleaning station with grinder was also added across the street from the facility on city-owned property adjacent to the overflow gravel parking along with boat wash-down station.


