9. First person to spell the name on his/her card, wins the game.



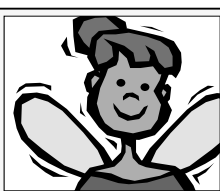

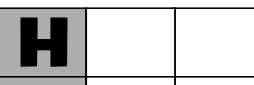




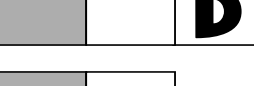
Kid Scoop Together

To reveal the answer, use the hints to fill in the empty boxes and create 3-letter words. The answer will appear by reading shaded boxes vertically.

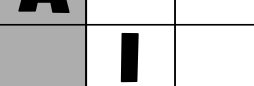

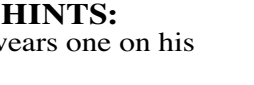

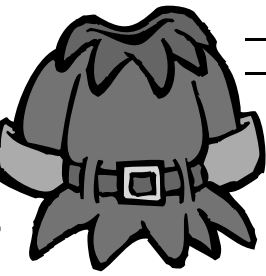

Elf Clothes

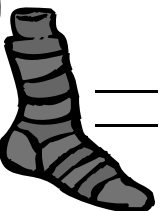
How tall is an elf? Here are some hints from Leroy, one of Santa's elves.

Measure my clothes and my head to see if you can figure out how tall I am.

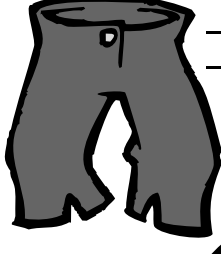




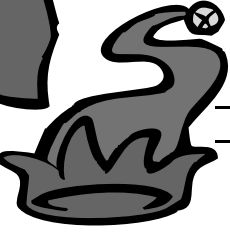

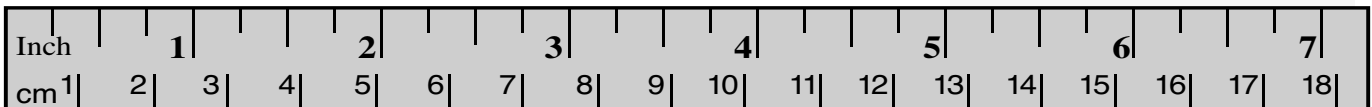
