ReVision Florence Streetscape Project set to begin February 2019 includes design engineering, right of way acquisition and administration, design review, construction, construction engineering, fixtures, and contingencies.

On Nov. 15, 2018, the ence and paving project bids were opened. Alex Hodge Construction, Inc. of Bend, Oregon, was the low bidder and was awarded the contract.

The construction costs for the streetscape portion of the total project are within FURA's ReVision Florence construction budget.
