Lane County Human Services seeks volunteers for annual Point-in-Time homeless count Jan. 31

Volunteers are needed to make this year's annual Point-in-Time Unsheltered Street Count as comprehensive as possible. Volunteer duties include collecting electronic surveys using the Survey 123 app and canvassing an assigned geographic area for people experiencing homelessness. This year's Count will take place across Lane County between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Thursday, Jan. 31. A short training is provided prior to the count to help prepare volunteers for the count. One-night counts are required by the Department of Housing and Urban Development and Oregon Housing and Community Services, which provide funding for housing and services related to homelessness. 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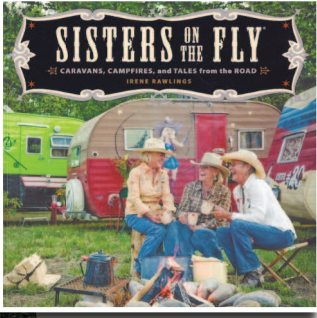
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
