City Lights celebrating Joni Mitchell's 75th birthday tomorrow

Honoring one of the world's most revered artists, Joni Mitchell, on her 75th birthday, "The Music Center Presents Joni 75: A Birthday Celebration" brings an incredible array of singers and musicians to the big screen at City Lights Cinemas on Thursday, Feb. 7, with showtimes at 12:30 and 6:30 p.m.

Local Joni Mitchell superfan Becky Goehring, who requested this event come to Florence, said, "I encourage all Joni Mitchell fans to come and bring someone who hasn't fully experienced her

to this screening."

Captured live at the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion, this special event features Brandi Carlile; Glen Hansard; Emmylou Harris; Norah Jones; Chaka Khan; Diana Krall; Kris Kristofferson; Los Lobos with La Marisoul, Cesar Castro and Xochi Flores; Graham Nash; James Taylor; Seal; and Rufus Wainwright, who will perform many of Mitchell's songs.

A music icon whose work continues to inspire generations of artists, Mitchell performed on the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion stage in 1972 and 1974, with the Los Angeles Times describing her 1972 concert as "Joni Mitchell in a Giant Living Room."

Goehring stated what

many have felt over Joni's long performing life:

"Joni Mitchell was an evocative female voice in my youth, bending my musical ear away from 'The Monkees' and other light pop-child tunesmiths. She inspired an instant connection at a time when my world view was expanding and helped me recognize, through many of her lyrics, that I had a part to play in my worlds, both personal and communal.

"The 'Big Yellow Taxi' changed my perception of the rapid development in my community, she put words to those first emerging feelings of love in 'A Case Of You,' and helped me see 'Both Sides Now' in so many places in my life.

"These and many other

songs will be interpreted on stage in this thrilling concert event."

With nine Grammy awards to her name and 16 Grammy nominations, Mitchell's catalog of music spans more than five decades. In 2017, Mitchell's 1971 album "Blue" was named number one on National Public Radio's list of the 150 greatest albums made by women.

Her work has no boundaries and crosses genres from folk and pop, to jazz and world music.

Mitchell is also a prolific painter and was once quoted as saying, "I'm a painter first, and a musician second."

While Mitchell hails from Canada, she has called Los Angeles home for decades.

Community Coalition to hear about NEDCO, asset bulding today

The Florence Area Community Coalition will have Luis Mendoza as its speaker at the monthly meeting to-

day, Feb. 6, from 9 to 10:30 a.m. in the Bromley Room of the Siuslaw Public Library, 1460 Ninth St. in Florence.

Mendoza is the supervisor of the Lane County Asset Building team of NEDCO. He will provide information about the NEDCO-City of Florence partnership to develop a cottage cluster of homes using the community land trust model at the old Senior Center site on Airport Road. The project will cluster small homes around a common space shared by the entire development.

The current plan proposes 12 homes, a mix of one-, two- and three-bedroom units, which will be for sale to households with incomes below 80 percent area medi-

an income.

The development will use the land trust model to ensure long-term affordability for buyers with low in-comes.

Land trusts are a unique form of home ownership, which have been successfully used around the nation, where the land itself is legally separated from the structures and held in trust by a non-profit (NEDCO).

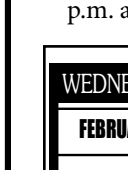

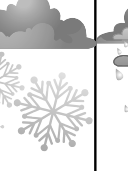
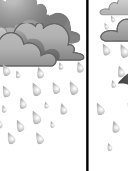
