The Western Lane Ambulance District (WLAD) Board of Directors invite applications from residents interested in serving on the

WLAD's Budget Committee. Interested persons should obtain an application from the SVFR station located at 2625 Highway 101, or from the WLAD website at www.westernlaneambulance.com.

Applications will be accepted until 5 p.m., Friday, March 15.

After the review of applications, the WLAD Board will appoint members at their March 20 joint board meet-

ing. Applicants must be registered voters residing within the WLAD district.

The Budget Committee is a standing committee of five members that sits jointly with the WLAD Directors to publicly review and revise the annual budget. The Budget Committee approves the budget, permanent tax rate and local option levy.

The budget then goes to the WLAD Board of Direc-

tors to be adopted.

Committee members serve three-year terms which expire on Dec. 31. A Budget Committee member is expected to spend up to 20 hours that includes reviewing the budget and meeting one to three times from April through June each year.
