Paul Morocco developed ‘Olé!’ after cutting his performing teeth on the streets of New Orleans. There, he explored his love for entertaining the public, learning the timeless craft of connecting to the au-

dience and developing his unique improvisational skills.

The original ‘Olé!’ show began at London’s Mime Festival in 1990, and debuted at Edinburgh’s Fringe Festival in 1991, receiving not one, but two awards for the performance.

In 1996, Paul teamed up with Guillermo De Endaya and Marcial Heredia. This version of the show plays to enraptured audiences to this day, and has become an international cult hit all over the World.
