HISTORY

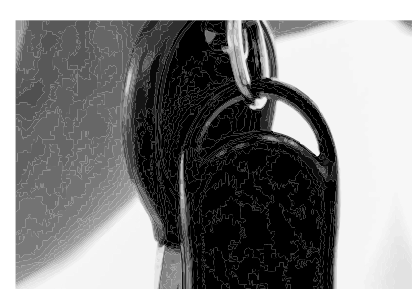
- **1868:** PRESIDENT ANDREW JOHNSON AVOIDS CONVICTION ON IMPEACHMENT CHARGES.

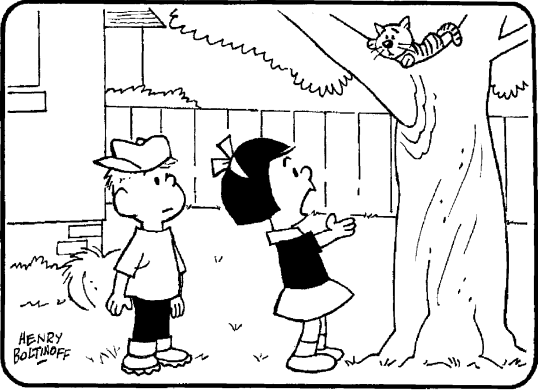

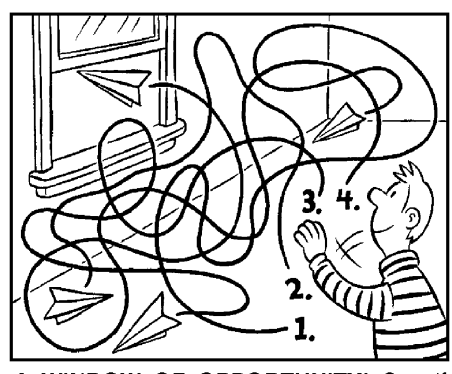

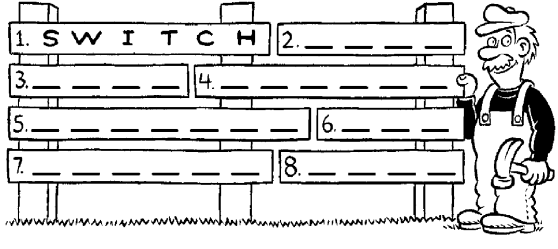
A WINDOW OF OPPORTUNITY! See if you can guess which paper plane made it to the outside world. You only get one try.

Junior Whirl

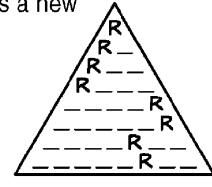
