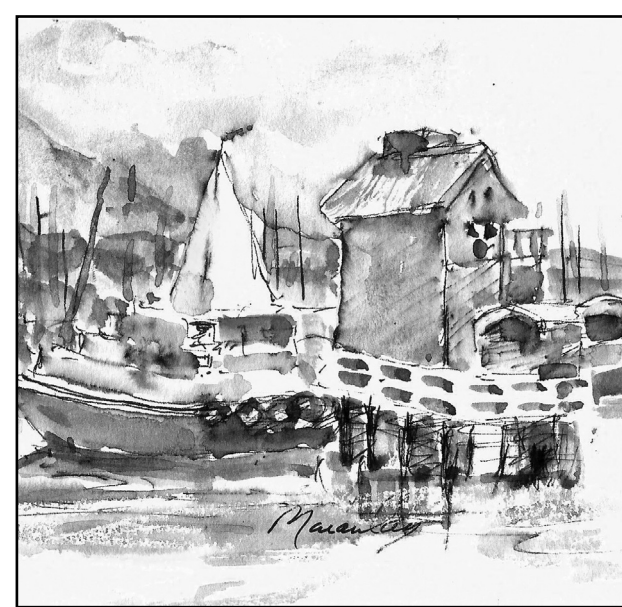

FRAA to host three-day Pocket Sketching watercolor workshop

Florence Regional Arts Alliance (FRAA) has announced an upcoming 3-day workshop, "Pocket Sketching for Fun and Travel" by critically-acclaimed traveling artist Kath Macaulay. Pocket Sketching is the perfect technique for travel journaling, hiking, biking, sauntering, sitting in a café or the airport. Participants will learn to capture what they see in 25 minutes or less using a water soluble pen, a 4 x 6-inch pad of paper and a small paint set. As, Macaulay explains, "This class is ideal for the

timid beginner to paint fearlessly in public, and the advanced artist who wants minimal equipment, total portability, speed, no interruptions and no clean-up. Learn enough to play for a lifetime." Nationally known and based in Tucson, Ariz., Macaulay travels the country teaching her technique. Her workshops are attended by both professional artists and those who have had no experience since grade school. "The workshop format is very hands on — almost like an army boot camp," says Macaulay. Day one will include basic technique and landscape; day two will be still life and people; and day three will be on location, plein air, "using the technique fearlessly anywhere," Macaulay says.
