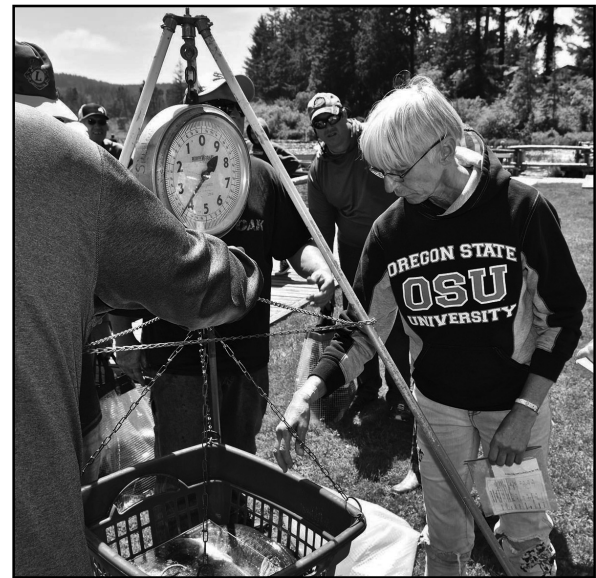


Siuslaw Valley to conduct structure burn exercise Saturday

Members of Siuslaw Valley Fire & Rescue will be conducting an Acquired Structure Training Burn on South Ferry Road, just south of the Siuslaw River Bridge, on Saturday. The training exercise will allow firefighters to practice fire suppression and safety techniques during a live controlled burn. The exercise will begin at 8 a.m. and will likely produce large amounts of smoke off and on throughout the training, which will last several hours. 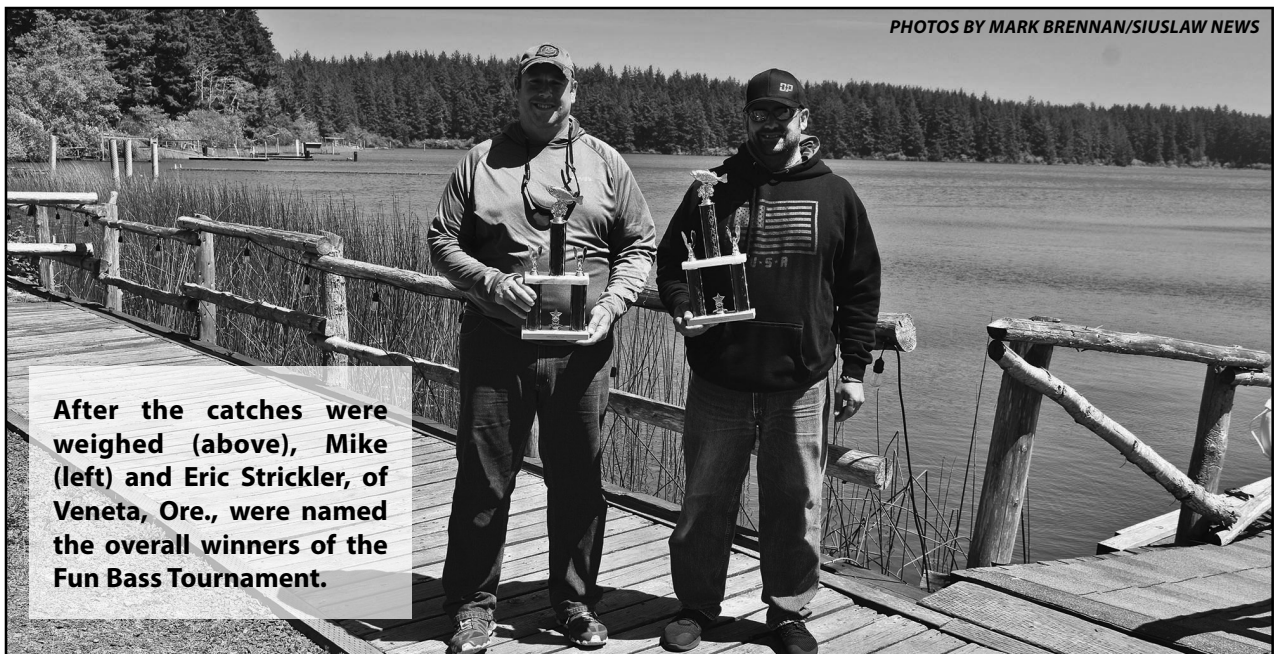

Women's Big Fish winner was Rebecca Schaeffner and Youth Big Fish winner was Trini Hindman.

Besides the fishing tour-

namment, the Florence Siuslaw Lions Club also coordinates the popular Wings and Wheels Car Show and Fly-in event, held annually at the Florence Municipal Airport, which raises the majority of money for the Lions Club's programs. 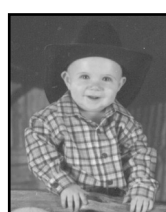
