Learn the fundamentals of a living trust June 18

What happens to someone's estate after they die? While some leave the question to probate courts, retirement specialist and local resident Ralph Ray advocates a "living trust" instead, and will speak on the legal practice in the Siuslaw Library's Bromley Room on Tuesday, June 18.

A living trust is a legal device that can be used to manage a person's property during their lifetime and to distribute their property after their death.

"If you think a will pro-

fects you and your loved ones upon death, you may or may not be correct," Ray said. "A will is only effective after you die. ... A living trust establishes you as the engineer of your financial destiny now, before you pass away. A living trust gives you power and control over all of your assets now and after death. This legal document offers privacy in estate disbursement which the government cannot stand against."

The free, 40-minute presentation will begin at 11:30 a.m., and again at 3:30 p.m.



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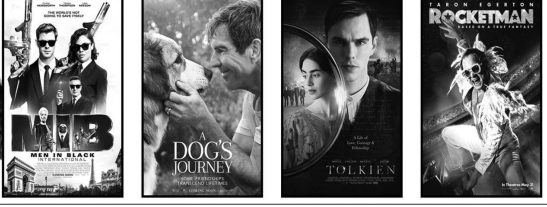

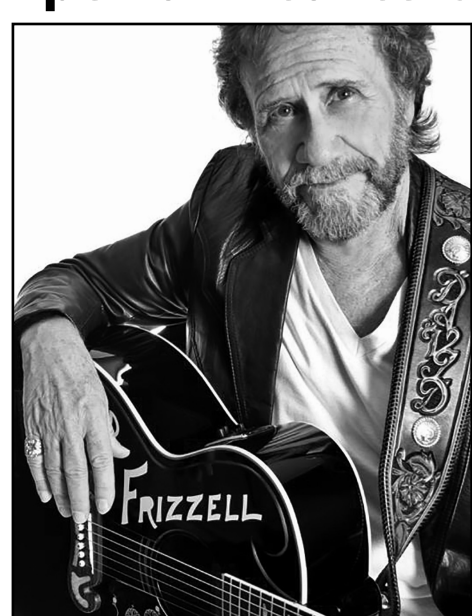
Country stars Frizzell, Clawson perform concert

Country star David Frizzell will be in concert Thursday, June 27. at the Florence Events Center (FEC), 715 Quince St.

Known for such chart-topping hits as "I'm Gonna Hire a Wino to Decorate Our Home" and "You're the Reason God Made Oklahoma," Frizzell is both legacy and legend in country music.

Frizzell's life and career are tightly woven into the fabric of country music history and lore. Whether writing, producing, touring, or performing, he is a timeless and tireless entertainer who continues to share his many gifts to the delight of fans old and new throughout the world.

Opening for Frizzell will be international award-winning singer/songwriter and CMA recording artist Amy Clawson. Clawson, an Arkansas native, started her successful professional career as a teen. She grew up



on country music with influences from rock, gospel and blues which colored the sound that eventually was to become so uniquely hers. Her shows span traditional country, rockin' original country, and gospel.

Clawson has hit number one on the charts with the duet "Why Wasn't It Me?" with Frizzell, and as a solo act with, "Cowboy Up." Her most recent singles include "She Loved" and "Still Breathing." She was instrumental in establishing the Bi-Mart Willamette Country Music Festival, and the Cape Blanco, Mountain Home, and Country Crossings Mu-

sic Festivals with co-host Pam Tillis. Clawson's exciting career includes performances alongside legendary entertainers like Blake Shelton, Florida-Georgia Line, Carrie Underwood, Toby Keith, Alabama and many others.

Each is a powerful, inspiring performer in their own right, but their collaborations and unique harmonies are favorites of country music listeners around the world.

"This will be a tremendous show," FEC Director Kevin Rhodes said. "Individually, David and Amy are excellent performers with a great play-

list of traditional country music; and when they collaborate, it's incredible. You will have a great evening."

Clawson will kick-off the exciting evening at 7:30, Frizzell will perform after a short intermission, and Clawson will join Frizzell for part of his show. The duo won the European Country Music Association's collaboration of the year for the "Frizzell and Friends" album. There will be a meet-and-greet with Frizzell and Clawson for ticket holders at 6:30 p.m.

Tickets are \$24.99, and \$14.99 for 18 and under, at the box office, EventCenter.org, or 541-997-1994.

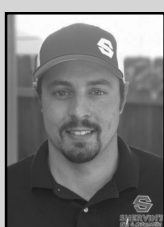
