The North Jetty Park is currently owned by DSL gon Parks and Recreation Department.

The park is zoned "Park Recreation" and and "Beach/Dunes." This largely undeveloped park includes beach access, an informal trail system, a dive dock, portable restrooms, ponds and stands of shore pine.
