Lane County Parks to hold public meeting on N. Jetty lease

Lane County Parks is considering entering into a long-term lease with the Oregon Department of State Lands (DSL) for the North Jetty Park in Florence, and will be holding a community meeting to discuss the prospect on Monday, June 24, from 6 to 7:30 p.m.

North Jetty Park is 250 acres that abuts Lane County's popular Harbor Vista Campground and is south of Heceta Beach.

The North Jetty Park is currently owned by DSL

and operated by the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department.

The park is zoned "Park and Recreation" and "Beach/Dunes." This largely undeveloped park includes beach access, an informal trail system, a dive dock, portable restrooms, ponds and stands of shore pine.

According to ORPD's annual car counts, the park receives an average of 114,000 visits annually.

"Incorporating North Jetty into our county parks

system is likely to have several benefits for the nearby community, including more regular maintenance and park ranger presence," said Lane County Parks Manager Brett Henry. "However, before the Board of Commissioners makes any decisions, we want to hear any concerns, hopes or suggestions from the neighbors and other community members."

The community meeting will take place at Siuslaw Valley Fire and Rescue, located at 2625

Highway 101. A short survey is also available online at www.docs.google.com/forms/d/e/1FAIpQLSdbzMPfQTEPA9orpfxmL7z4guJGejvl4LYGgWDpG-vyOG25Qg/viewform.

There is no deadline for the Board of Commissioners to make a decision. Information gathered during the community meeting and from the survey will be shared with commissioners as they consider any next steps.

decades and now offers one-stop shopping for most needs. Hours are going to remain the same, each day from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m.

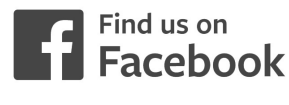
"Navigating the county process and engineers alone is huge, certainly not user-friendly," Ambrosio said about the biggest challenge to the project. "But it was worth it."

Peace Harbor seeks Patient Advisory Council members

PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Medical Center is seeking to expand membership on its Patient and Family Advisory Council (PFAC).

Anyone who has had experience as a hospital patient or family member of a patient is eligible to serve as a PFAC advisor.

Members must be good collaborators and must commit to attend monthly meetings and set aside sufficient time between meetings — three hours is a good estimate — for preparation, research or project work.

hospital on the second Monday of the month from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. Lunch is provided.

Candidates must attend a brief interview and then register as a Peace Harbor volunteer before joining the council.

PFAC advisors help improve the patient experience by offering their unique perspective by giving feedback on hospital communications, programs, services and systems.

on a variety of hospital committees.
