


Even Exchange by Donna Pettman

CLAM SLAM SLAP SOAP SOUP


THIS CLAM CHOWDER IS TOO FRESH

Answer: 1. MILL, RILL, RILE, RICE, RACE; 2. HOME, HONE, LONE, LANE, LAND; 3. DUCK, BUCK, BULK, BULL, BILL; 4. COLD, HOLD, HELD, HEAD, HEAT; 5. BACK, BECK, BEAK, BEAT, SEAT.


