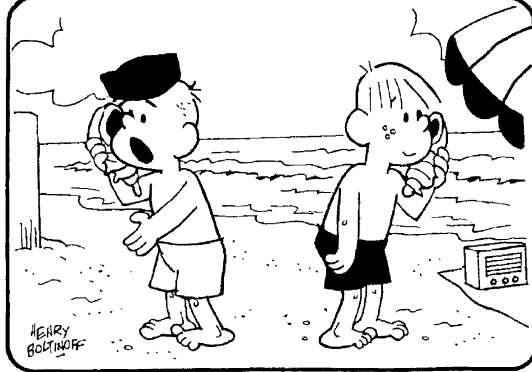

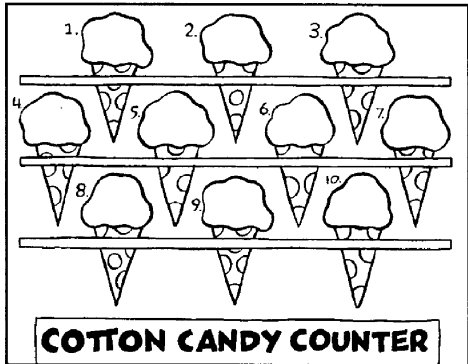

IT'S VACATION TIME!

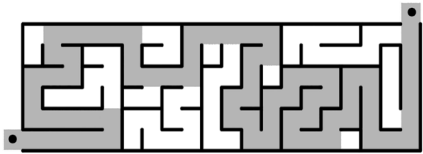

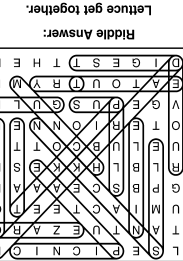
