education programs.

In 2018, SOS provided direct aid to 3,001 local individuals. Last year's tournament raised more than \$11,000 for those facing some form of crisis.

The tournament, now in its ninth year, features a hole-in-one contest for a 2019 Ford F-150 truck, courtesy of Johnston Motors Company, a chance to putt for \$5,000, and many team and individual contest prizes.

The tournament is a four-person team format using the Calloway scoring method. Team fees are \$350 or \$89 for an individual, and teams can be formed with unattached players. Fees include green fees, carts, drinks, coffee, donuts, snacks and lunch.
