## Peace Harbor to begin offering monthly childbirth, newborn class

The Women's Services team at PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Medical Center has launched a new monthly Childbirth and Newborn Care Class for expectant parents.

The daylong class is held the second Saturday of the month, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. in Conference Room D at Peace Harbor, 400 Ninth St.

This month's meeting is today, Aug. 10.

This class is intended to help expectant parents prepare for one of life's most rewarding yet challenging experiences — the birth of a baby.

Taught by Peace Harbor labor and delivery nurses, the class covers all aspects of childbirth, as well as lactation and caring for your newborn.

Lunch and a tour of the delivery unit are included.

All expectant parents are encouraged to attend — both those who are having their first child, and those who want a refresher. Participants should dress comfortably and bring one or two pillows, as well as their partners or labor supporters.

Registration is required as class size is limited, so call 541-897-9048 to register.

## Volunteers needed for DA's Victim Services program

The Lane County District Attorney's Office needs new volunteers to help support its Victim Services Division.

Volunteers serve as victim advocates and work with people who have been victims of crimes being prosecuted by the District Attorney's Office.

"This is an incredibly rewarding place to volunteer," said Lori Silano, director of Victim Services. "Many of our volunteers stay year after year because of the powerful connections they make with one another and clients as they work to help victims of crime under-

stand their rights and participate in the legal system."

Volunteers will be selected through an application and interview process. Eligible individuals must be at least 18 years of age, able to pass a complete criminal background check, and be willing to commit eight hours per week for a one-year period.

Hours are between 8 a.m. and noon, Monday through Friday. Applicants are not required to have knowledge of, or experience in, legal or counseling services.

Successful volunteers are those who possess a wide

variety of talents and life experiences.

The application deadline is Aug. 14 and applications are available online.

Selected volunteers will receive classroom instruction along with one-on-one training in the areas of the criminal justice system, victimology, crisis intervention and other areas necessary to become a successful victim advocate.

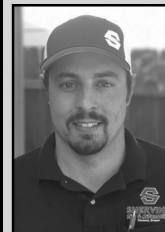
