Sheriffs still seeking information on two area shootings

Lane County Sheriff's Office (LCSO) is still seeking assistance in locating a shooting suspect in Florence. It has now been confirmed that three separate shootings involving the sale of heroin between July 18 and Aug. 9 took place county wide.

Deputies and detectives have identified the suspects in each shooting. LCSO's investigation indicates the shootings were not committed by the same suspects and are unrelated, with the exception that they occurred around the sale of heroin.

The two suspects identified in the Aug. 9 shooting have been located and arrested. Detectives are still searching for the suspects identified from the July 19 Glenwood shooting and the July 29 Florence shooting, and are asking anyone who knows where Juan Hernandez-Burboa or Gene Manuel Joseph are to call 541-682-4141.

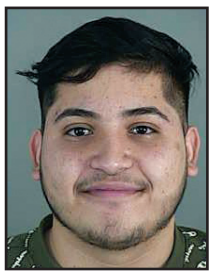
On July 19, two males entered a residence at the Ponderosa Mobile Village in Glenwood and shots were fired during a heroin sale, injuring a 31-year-old male.

Juan Israel Hernandez-Burboa of Eugene, 20, has been identified as a suspect in the shooting and deputies are still searching for him.

People are asked to not

attempt to contact Hernandez-Burboa as he is considered to be armed and dangerous.

On July 29, LCSO responded to PeaceHealth Peace Harbor Hospital in Florence regarding a gunshot wound victim who was reportedly shot in the leg earlier in the day in an area south of Florence off Highway 101.

A 32-year-old male was shot in a dispute over a large amount of heroin believed to be stolen from the suspect, Gene Manuel Joseph. Deputies have been searching for Joseph since the incident and believe that he is still in the Florence area.

People are asked to not attempt to contact or ap-

prehend Joseph as he is considered armed and dangerous.

Joseph, 35, is described as a white male standing 5'10" tall and weighing approximately 200 pounds. He has black hair and brown eyes, and may have a long, black beard.

On Aug. 9, deputies responded to a shooting involving a heroin sale at the Sailor Pioneer Cemetery in Noti.

Detectives quickly identified two suspects in the shooting, 34-year-old Samuel Ferguson, unknown city of residence, and 24-year-old Jazmine Sherman of Cottage Grove, whose 19-month-old child was reportedly in the backseat of the vehicle during the incident.

Ferguson and Sherman were both arrested on Aug. 9.

LCSO is asking anyone who has seen Joseph or Hernandez-Burboa, or knows where they are, to call 541-682-4141.

After spending his youth in Portland, Lee turned an electrical engineering degree from Oregon State University into a 36-year career with Bo-

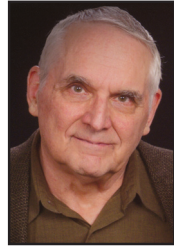
ing in Seattle, Wash. His expertise in Avionics System Design became highly recognized and respected.
