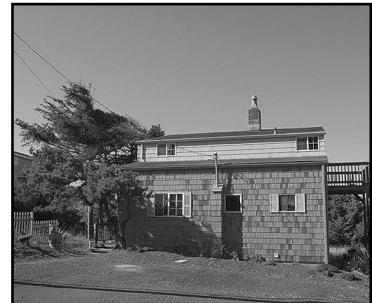
The first meeting of the year will be on Monday, Aug. 26, in the Siuslaw High School library at 6:30 p.m.
