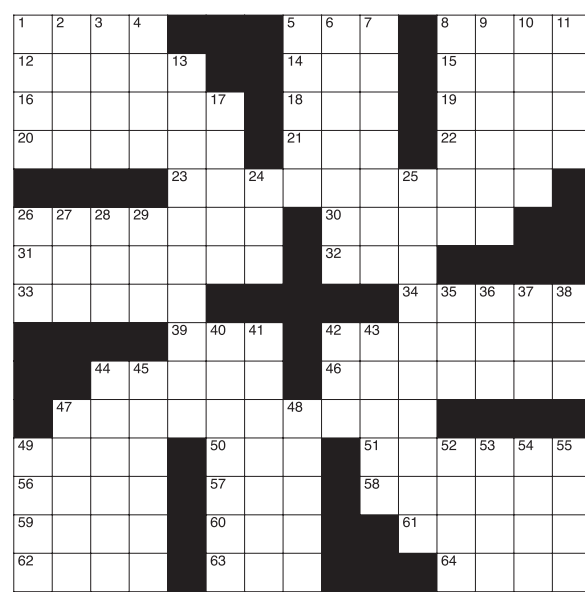


For growing vegetables in the cooler months, it's important to:
