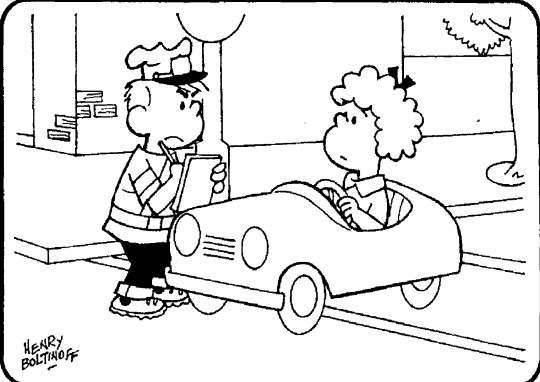

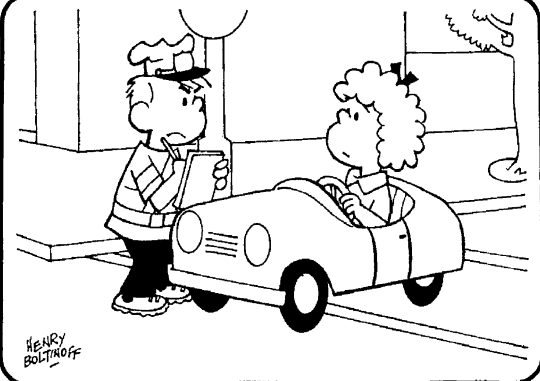
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HOCUS-FOCUS

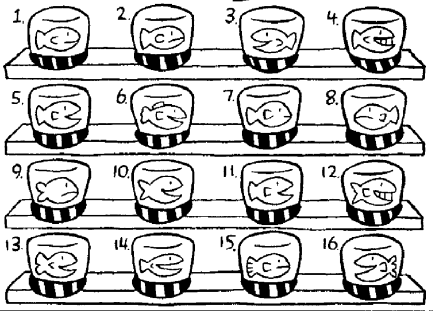
Find at least six differences in details between panels.

Answer: Caps 5 and 11.

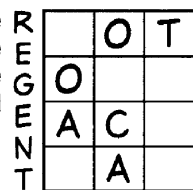
AN ALPHABET PARTY!

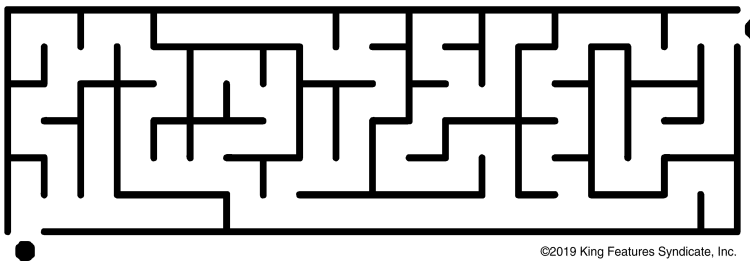
