

Documentary 'Mike Wallace Here' to play at City Lights Sept. 4, 7

The new documentary covering the career of legendary broadcast journalist Mike Wallace, most famous for his stint on "60 Minutes," comes to City Lights Cinemas this Wednesday, Sept. 4, at noon and 5:40 p.m., with an encore Saturday, Sept. 7, at noon.

This documentary exposé of 60 Minutes' newsman Mike Wallace turns his hard-hitting, no-holds-barred journalistic style loose on Wallace himself, who is considered by many to be the inventor of the form.

Wallace unflinchingly interrogated the biggest figures of the 20th century. During 50 years on the air, his aggressive reporting style and showmanship redefined what America has come to expect from broadcasters.

As riveting as it is topical, "Mike Wallace Is Here" mirrors its subject's scrupulous gaze to better understand how the nation arrived at the precarious media tipping point being experienced today.

Exhuming decades of never-before-seen footage from the "60 Minutes" vault, filmmaker Avi Belkin crafts an all-archival portrait that explores what drove and plagued the restless reporter whose storied career and troubled personal life were inherently entwined with the evolu-

tion of broadcast journalism itself. Regular ticket prices apply: \$9.50 for adult, \$8.50 for senior, \$8 for matinee and \$6.50 for members. Tickets for all three showings are currently available at City Lights Cinemas, 1930 Highway 101, or online at citylightscinemas.com.

Figure 8 portrait group to be featured at library in September

Among the membership are oil painters, watercol-

orists, pastelists, sketchers and those who paint with acrylics.

This show will be different than previous shows, in that there will be a self-portrait of each artist displayed as part of the show.
