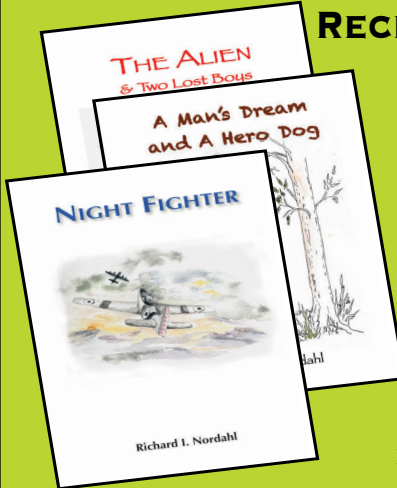
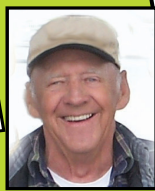

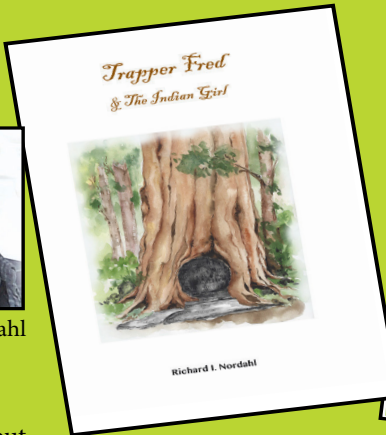


Previous Books of Fiction

A fiction book of old times and adventure - Richard's fourth story.

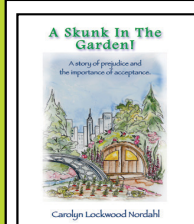


Tony & The Princess Irene Marie

This is the story of my home, my family, and my Oregon childhood. The book also contains many old family recipes and my personal watercolor illustrations.



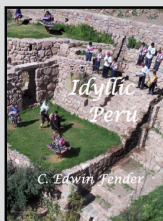
A Skunk In The Garden!

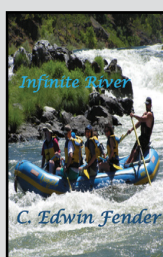
C. EDWIN (ED) FENDER

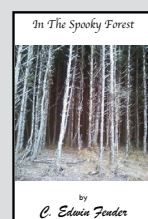
