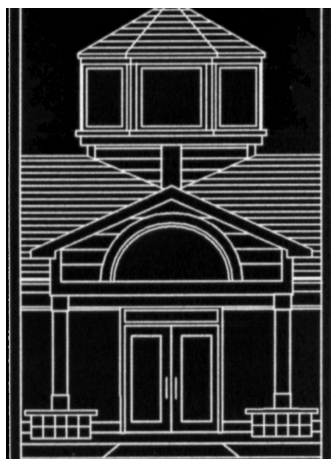

Kurlansky is the popular author of many books, including "Cod, Salt, Paper, Havana, The Basque History of the World" and "The Big Oyster."
