Details confirmed by state regarding surplus 'kicker' for 2018 tax year

A more than \$1.5 billion tax surplus was confirmed by the Office of Economic Analysis (OEA) earlier this month, triggering a tax surplus credit, or "kicker," for the 2018 tax year. Instead of kicker checks, the surplus will be returned to taxpayers through a credit on their 2019 state personal income tax returns filed in 2020. To calculate the amount of your credit, multiply your 2018 tax liability before any credits — line 22 on the 2018 Form OR-40

— by 16 percent. This percentage is determined and certified by OEA. Taxpayers who claimed a credit for tax paid to another state will need to subtract the credit amount from their liability before calculating the credit. You're eligible to claim the kicker if you filed a 2018 tax return and had tax due before credits. Even if you don't have a filing obligation for 2019, you still must file a 2019 tax return to claim your credit.

There will be detailed information on how to claim your credit in the 2019 Oregon personal income tax return instructions: Form OR-40 for full-year Oregon residents, Form OR-40-P for part-year residents, and Form OR-40-N for nonresidents. Composite and fiduciary-income tax return filers are also eligible. Keep in mind that the state may use all or part of your kicker to pay any state debt you owe, such as tax due for other years,

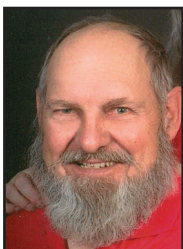
child support, court fines or school loans. A What's My Kicker? calculator will be active on Revenue's website for personal income tax filers when filing season opens in January. To calculate your kicker, you'll enter your name, Social Security Number, and filing status for 2018 and 2019. Visit www.oregon.gov/dor to get tax forms, check the status of your refund, or make tax payments; call 800-356-4222 toll-

free from an Oregon prefix (English or Spanish); 503-378-4988 in Salem and outside Oregon; or email questions.dor@oregon.gov. For TTY (hearing or speech impaired), call 800-886-7204.

Dunes City to hold work session on outdoor lighting regulations

Dunes City's Planning Commission will hold a special work session on Monday, Oct. 28, to discuss outdoor lighting and potential regulations. Dunes City residents are invited to participate in the discussion. The work session will be held at Dunes City Hall beginning at 5 p.m. Dunes City staff has seen an increase in the number of complaints from residents about intrusive nighttime lights. Dunes City Council has

authorized the Planning Commission to explore regulations for outdoor lighting similar to those in place in other small cities. The Planning Commission is looking for citizen input on reducing outdoor lighting glare and intrusion onto adjacent property while achieving a balance between safety and aesthetics. Friends of Florence Drivers needed

Friends of Florence is seeking new drivers. This free bus service, for cancer patients who are receiving radiation treatment, operates Monday through Friday all year long. A driver's shift requires approximately five hours, from 7:30 a.m. to noon. Volunteers typically drive once per month. "Cancer patients have to travel to Eugene or Springfield daily for these radiation treatments—it's 160 miles roundtrip from Florence," said Bart Mealer, Chief Operating Officer for the organization. "Riding the bus helps ease the stress during this difficult time." The Friends' bus is a 14-passenger vehicle. A commercial driver's license is not required. "It's about the same size as a small RV," Mealer added.

For over 33 years, the Friends of Florence, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, has transported patients roundtrip from Florence to the Willamette Valley Cancer Institute and to the Oregon Urology Institute. The bus leaves from Peace Health Peace Harbor Hospital and, when requested, has pick-up locations in Mapleton and Veneta. The Friends maintain about 22 active drivers. "Riding the bus also offers companionship for patients who are making this trip every day. It shows them that they're not alone," said Mealer. "It's a traveling support group."
