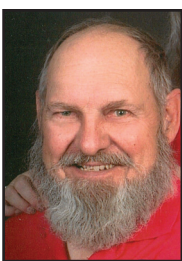

## Dunes City to discuss outdoor lighting regulations

Dunes City’s Planning Commission will hold a special work session on Monday, Oct. 28, to discuss outdoor lighting and potential regulations.

Dunes City residents are invited to participate in the discussion. The work session will be held at Dunes

City Hall beginning at 5 p.m.

Dunes City staff has seen an increase in the number of complaints from residents about intrusive nighttime lights.

Dunes City Council has authorized the Planning Commission to explore

regulations for outdoor lighting similar to those in place in other small cities.

The Planning Commission is looking for citizen input on reducing outdoor lighting glare and intrusion onto adjacent property while achieving a balance between safety and aesthet-

## New landslide prep guide available from DOGAMI, DLCD

The Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD) and the Oregon Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) have released Preparing for Landslide Hazards: A Land Use Guide for Oregon Communities and its accompanying quick reference handout.

In response to community conversations throughout Oregon, DLCD and DOGAMI jointly pursued and obtained grant funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The Land Use Guide responds to frequently asked community questions related to increasing local resilience to landslide hazards through land use options and strategies. Many of these questions come from communities with new DOGAMI lidar-based landslide maps.

DOGAMI has used lidar to produce detailed landslide inventories, shallow landslide susceptibility maps, and deep landslide susceptibility maps for many communities in Oregon.

With this new information, communities should to revise local codes, plans, and policies to most effectively use the lidar-based landslide inventory and maps.

The goal of the Land Use Guide is to address the information gaps faced by communities with new lidar-based landslide maps.

The Land Use Guide provides:

- Explanations of the general types of landslide hazards. (Chapter 2)
- Results of a limited review of landslide regulations. (Chapters 4, 5, and 8)
- Key issues in implementing landslide hazard risk reduction. (Chapters 4 and 5)
- Discussions of comprehensive plan and implementation (e.g. zoning codes, building codes, and so forth) issues.
- Elements of a strong comprehensive plan related to landslide hazards, examples of comprehensive plan provisions from Oregon communities, and a model framework for comprehensive plan revisions. (Chapters 3 and 5)
- Elements of a strong landslide hazard ordinance, example code provisions from Oregon communities, and a model framework for a landslide hazard ordinance. (Chapters 4 and 5)

- Key ways to reduce a community’s risk from landslide hazards. (Chapter 4)

The Land Use Guide and accompanying quick reference handout are located on both DLCD’s and DOGAMI’s websites.
