The breakup between the longtime medical services partners has been somewhat acrimonious throughout the year. PeaceHealth first started providing Medicare Advantage plans with Health Net back in 2004, and with Trillium in 2012. Both insurers are owned by Centene Corporation.

According to PeaceHealth, last April, they informed both insurers that they were no longer renewing their contract and would, instead, work with other providers for Medicare Advantage. Details surrounding the decision are unknown, with PeaceHealth reiterating, "This is part of our ongoing efforts to streamline our Medicare partners," when asked by the Siuslaw News

about the decision.

Centene Corporation did not return a request for comment.

However, since April, Health Net and Trillium

split until October, when they began receiving letters from PeaceHealth offering new plans. Many patients were confused by the news, with some worrying that

PeaceHealth and are either turned away or receive a much larger bill. At that point, open enrollment will be over and the consumers will not be able to purchase a different policy until open enrollment in October 2020."

On Oct. 28, the federal judge over the case ordered the two insurers to alert consumers that Medicare plans for 2020 will no longer include PeaceHealth, stating, "The public has a right to know that the largest provider in the

regions at issue will no longer be 'in plan,' and the time to be so informed is during open enrollment."

The judge required Trillium and Health Net to include a banner headline on the front page of their websites informing all patients of the change.

have allegedly been misrepresenting the split to insurance brokers, stating that negotiations were still ongoing. Both providers' websites still listed PeaceHealth as "in-network" on their websites as well.

Because of this, many patients were unaware of the
