## City hydrant flushing begins

Beginning yesterday, Nov. 12, the City of Florence began conducting its annual Hydrant Flushing Program. The flushing program will last approximately 12 weeks.

Flushing the water main is a normal preventive maintenance procedure to improve water quality, safety and test the system regarding fire-flows.

This program is an important part of the City of Florence's ability to provide fire protection service and to ensure that all hydrants on the system are in good working condition.

City of Florence Public Works personnel will be flushing the hydrants Monday through Friday between 7:30 a.m. and 2 p.m.

The water is safe to use during this flushing period. Some areas may experience discolored or cloudy water during this time, but this will only be temporary. The temporary discoloration of the water is an unavoidable effect from flushing the water lines and has no harmful health effects.
