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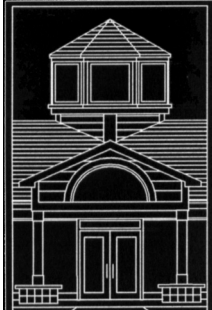

Book Review

“The Secrets We Kept”
by Lara Prescott

Lara Prescott’s irresistible debut novel is an electrifying literary page-turner that captures the passion and courage of three unforgettable women: Sally and Irina, two brilliant secretaries in the CIA’s typing pool who become spies at the height of the Cold War, and whose ability to keep secrets catapults them into a world of danger, love and international espionage; and Olga, Boris Pasternak’s mistress and muse, who was sent to the Gulag for refusing to divulge the plot of his novel “Doctor Zhivago” to Soviet agents, and who remained his mistress until the day he died.

“The Secrets We Kept” is based on the true story of the CIA’s clandestine attempt to smuggle Pasternak’s banned masterpiece behind the Iron Curtain — a mission grounded in the tantalizing belief that a work of art can pierce through a web of lies, and that a book has the power to change the world.

Glamorous, sophisticated Sally Forrester has honed her gift for deceit all over the world, using her magnetism and charm to pry secrets out of powerful men. Sally is tasked with training Irina, the newest member of the typing pool and her polar opposite; shy, soft-spoken, the daughter of a Russian-born seamstress, Irina stands out in the typing pool precisely because she doesn’t stand out in the typing pool.

During the day, she takes dictation, transcribes notes and remains silent during the agency’s all-male meetings. Under Sally’s tutelage, she quickly discovers a hidden power and purpose, learning how to take a package from a passerby on K Street during rush hour and keep walking without looking back, how to slip a piece of paper into the pocket of a man sitting next to her at a bar, and how to ferry classified documents all over Washington, D.C.

Together, Sally and Irina will covertly change the course of American history, all while remaining invisible. From Moscow to the horrors of the Gulag, from Washington, D.C., to Paris and Milan, “The Secrets We Kept” captures an extraordinary time and place with astonishing veracity and command. Epic, intimate, intensely vivid and gripping from its very first page, Prescott’s debut marks the arrival of a sensationally gifted new novelist.

Pounding for Florence Food Share on Saturday

The 19th annual Pounding to benefit Florence Food Share will be held at Grocery Outlet, 2066 Highway 101, on Saturday, Nov. 23, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Founded and hosted by local businesswoman Cindy Wobbe, this annual food drive aims to fill the food bank’s pantries with much needed canned, boxed and frozen food items in time for the holiday season.

“When everybody chips in, we can fill those shelves pretty quickly,” said Wobbe. “Over 650 families in our community rely on Florence Food Share to keep from going hungry each month, and that need is not going to go away. This food drive has been a godsend year after year.”

For the third year, Top Hydraulics, Inc. has announced that it will also match the total number of pounds donated.

“This corporate match means that for every pound we receive, Top Hydraulics will donate an additional \$1. It’s a significant and generous gift and that will impact so many who are in need,” Wobbe said.
