Sneak a Peek in Your Mailbox

- Receive text messages or e-mail alerts notifying that a package is en route and additional notifications when the package has been delivered.
- Provide delivery instructions

online and authorize the carrier to leave the package in a specific location.

- Request the package be held at the Post Office, by choosing the Hold for Pickup option.
- Redirect packages when you won't be home to receive it, by choosing the USPS Package Intercept option for an additional fee.

Skip the Trip and Ship Online

The Postal Service offers solutions designed specifically to make shipping holiday packages easy and convenient. Customers can avoid holiday hassles by:

- Ordering free Priority Mail and Priority Mail Express boxes and envelopes at usps.com/freeboxes, or pick them up at a local Post Office.
- Using Click-N-Ship at usps.com/ship to create shipping labels with USPS Tracking and pay for postage—with free flat-rate boxes, there's no need to weigh.
- Getting packages picked up for free at home or office with Package Pickup. Just hand the package to the mail carrier on his or her regular delivery route. Pickups can be scheduled at usps.com/pickup.

- Select a durable box to protect contents
- Do NOT reuse mailing boxes
- Properly address packages
- Print addresses clearly
- Place a card inside with delivery and return addresses
- Never guess a ZIP Code™
- Add all address elements including apartment numbers and directional information (ex: 123 S Main St. Apt. 2B).

This helps postal employees deliver the item should the mailing label become damaged or fall off.

Look up a ZIP Code™ at usps.com under Quick Tools. NO ZIP is better than a WRONG ZIP.
