Studio Florence begins Movement Art Workshop

Facilitator Lynn Underwood is starting a monthly Movement Art Workshop at Studio Florence, 1845 Highway 126 at the corner of Quince Street.

The class incorporates the percussive music from Gabrielle Roth's Five Sacred Rhythms — flowing, staccato, chaos, lyrical and stillness.

"We will move our bodies through each of the five segments of music and respond to each piece incrementally through intuitive/spontaneous painting as the layers build both rhythmically and

painterly," Underwood said. "For example, we will move through rhythm one and respond with a short painting response, then on to rhythm two followed by painting, and continue in this fashion through all five segments."

Students are then encouraged to respond with a short written response.

This monthly workshop meets the first Sunday of each month from 1 to 3 p.m. The cost is \$20.
