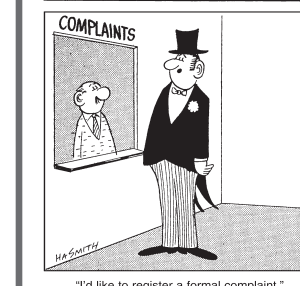
The Garden Bug Christmas rose

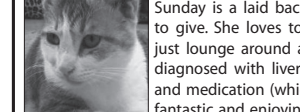
