Many of these are under the guidance of the Centers for Disease Control, with the minimal mandate encouraging social distancing.

"This includes limiting public and private gatherings, restricting restaurants to take-out and delivery services and extending school closures," said Henry, who added that now wasn't the time to point fingers or discriminate against those who may become infected.

"The virus does not discriminate. We cannot combat COVID-19 if we turn on each other or stigmatize people who test positive and become ill," Henry said. "That only puts sick people and the broader community at-risk because it discourages people from getting tested, getting care and staying home.

"We are all afraid of the unknown and how this virus will end up impacting our lives. It is our job to remain kind and supportive during these uncertain times."

"We will cease all gaming, hotel and restaurant activities on tribal property ... for the duration of two weeks."

Slyter said the casino's plan is to reopen April 1, with the tribe providing emergency paid leave and benefits for Three Rivers employees in both Florence and Coos Bay during the temporary closure period.

"We will continue to monitor the situation nationally and locally," he added.

"To protect safety and ensure social distancing, only a limited number of audience members will be allowed to attend the meeting. all entities other than C-Corporations, such as trusts or estates. IRS will automatically provide this relief to taxpayers. Taxpayers do not need to file any additional forms or call the IRS to qualify for this relief.

Penalties and interest will begin to accrue on any remaining unpaid balances as of July 16, 2020. If you file your tax return or request an extension of time to file by April 15, 2020, you will automatically avoid interest and penalties on the taxes paid by July 15."

This relief only applies to federal income tax (including tax on self-employment income) payments otherwise due April 15, 2020, not state tax payments or deposits or payments of any other type of federal tax.

Taxpayers also will need to file income tax returns in 42 states plus the District of Columbia. State filing and payment deadlines vary and are not always the same as


