mandolin orchestra. Her playing and singling were in great demand for home parties with family and friends.

Her spirited wanderlust spurred her to study English, acquire a green card, and sail to New York in June 1964.

Once on board, she met Richard, a fellow musician. This began a relationship that led to marriage and lasted more than 54 years.

During that time, with characteristic energy, determination and natural ability, Barbara not only raised a family, kept a productive garden, became an excellent seamstress and faithfully attended then led exercise classes, she also blossomed into an accomplished artist.

She first mastered toll painting, then oil and watercolor painting. Her flowers, still-lives, land-

scapes and painted Christmas balls showed meticulous attention to detail and — most importantly — life.

With early retirement, Barbara and Richard traveled, cruised, camped and explored their way through 24 memorable years.

Barbara is survived by her husband, Richard; her sister, Franziska; sons Anthony and Thomas and his wife, Janis, and their daughter, Sy.

Gene started commercial fishing at an early age on the Columbia River. He continued his career fishing tuna, crab and salmon to as far as Alaska.

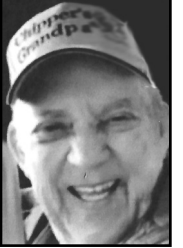

## Lane County shifts transfer stations to summer hours

Lane County's Glenwood and Florence transfer stations are experiencing record high customer volumes during peak times, resulting in longer than normal wait times and crowded conditions.

In an effort to reduce crowds, Lane County is reminding the community that its waste disposal sites have now shifted to summer operating hours.

In Florence, the transfer

station at 2820 Rhododendron Dr. is open Monday to Saturday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The Glenwood site is now open on Sundays and the Marcola, Oakridge, Rattlesnake and Vida transfer stations have expanded hours from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday.

People are encouraged to take advantage of these expanded hours.

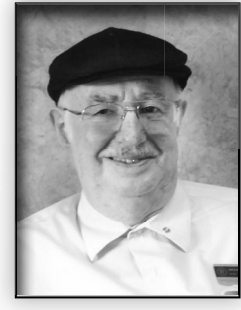
The times to avoid, if at all possible, are Saturdays and Mondays, mid-morning through the early afternoon.

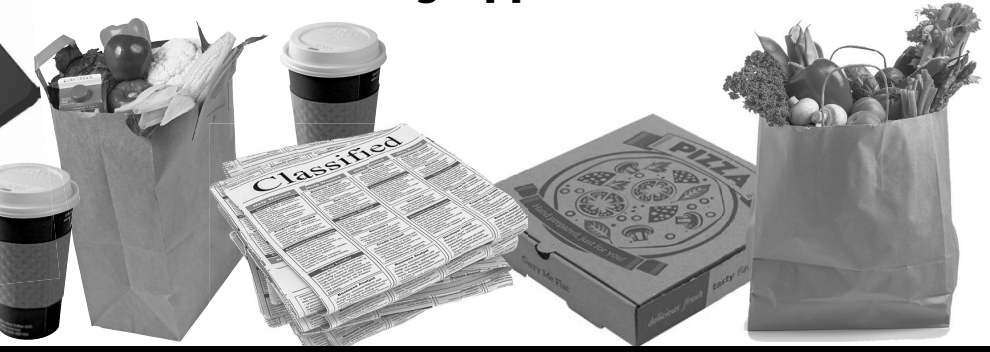
