Nyah releases four remixes of her ‘Thousand Wishes’ single

On Friday, local singer Nyah Vollmar released her song “A Thousand Wishes” as a maxi-single available for instant download. The song, which released in January through her EP “Disconnected,” now features four remixes from fellow artists at

InRage Entertainment. “The song, written by Nyah, has taken on a special meaning in the midst of the crisis we’re all facing,” stated InRage’s Facebook page. “This maxi-single has a little something for every type of music lover.” Nyah signed on with In-

Rage Entertainment, based out of Los Angeles, in 2018 and is an artist-in-development there. She works closely with Bruce “Automatic” and Ebony Rae Vanderveer on her music. In fact, Automatic’s apprentices Komplikated, M3DI and Zilly are all included in the maxi-single release. Ebony Rae also has the “Black Sandy Remix.”

That’s not all that makes this release special, however. A portion of all 2020 proceeds made from this release will be donated to Feeding America to help families in need during and after the Covid-19 pandemic.

Quoting her song, Nyah said, “‘I wish for you the best ...’ I’m thinking of you

all during this challenging time. I wanted to do something to help.”

According to her father Scott Vollmar, “When ‘Team Nyah’ first started planning for the release, it was Nyah who came up with the idea of donating to Feeding America. The rest of us came up with different ideas, our favorite causes, etc., but she was adamant that this is what she wanted to do, especially in light of current events. In addition to a personal donation, she directed 10 percent of revenue from 2020 sales/streams of the maxi-single be donated to Feeding America. InRage is 100% in her corner on this, but it’s her idea.”

Voter registration deadline approaches for May Primary

The voter registration deadline for the May 19,

2020 Primary Election is Tuesday, April 28, 2020. This is also the deadline for people to change their party affiliation.

“Oregon was the first state to begin conducting elections entirely by mail,” said Lane County Clerk Cheryl Betschart. “That means we will be able to move forward with the May 19 Primary Election and Oregon voters can cast their ballots from the safety of their own homes.”

Registration options include:

- Online at www.oregonvotes.gov no later than 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, April 28. The online option is available to those with a valid Oregon driver’s license, DMV-issued identification card or learner’s permit.
- Submit a voter registra-

tion form to the Elections Office by 5 p.m., Tuesday, April 28.

- Mail a voter registration card to the Elections Office postmarked no later than Tuesday, April 28.

The Lincoln Street ballot drop box at Lane County Elections in Eugene will be open through Tuesday, April 28, at 5 p.m. to make it easier for voters to drop off completed registration cards.

New voters who will turn 18 on or before the May 19 Election Day may register by the April 28 deadline and receive a ballot, even if they are still 17 on the deadline date.

Primary elections are held so the members of a party can choose the party’s candidates for office. The 40+ percent of Oregonians registered as not affiliated

with a political party, or registered with a minor party (Constitution, Independent, Libertarian, Pacific Green, Progressive, Working Families) will receive a ballot that includes only nonpartisan offices.

Due to COVID-19, the Lane County Elections Office is closed to walk-in appointments. Assistance is available over the phone at 541-682-4234 and via email at elections@lanecountyor.gov.

Voters with issues that cannot be resolved via phone or email will be able to make an appointment to visit the Elections Office.
